on Indian Concerns of Ohio & Indiana Yearly Meetings
& acquaint the latter Committee that the sum of
£1504 4⁰⁰/100 in possession of Joseph King jr. our
Treasurer is subject to their Draft. On considering
the expediency of entering upon an additional
subscription at this time we have concluded
that the sum on hand is sufficient for
present engagements & it was concluded to
defer further action in the matter until a

future period

a Communication to the Committee on Indian Concerns
of Indiana to be presented to our next ^{stated} meeting
