The Committee is informed by Joseph King Jr. Treasurer that he had permitted to James Stanton Springfield Wren & Co Ohio on the 30th of 11^{mo} 1840 last a "Bank of Baltimore" Certificate of Deposit for 130 \$ on our account it being the amount in his hands to that date.

The Com^y on the request of the late Sarah Fane were again continued.

The Com^y was informed that the report to the late Quarterly Meeting had been signed & presented.

They adjourned to the State house in the 3rd mo next to meet at H. B. Alderston's at 4th Clock P.M.

The Committee on the bequest of the late Sarah Fane are continued.

Hugh Balderson, Joseph King and William Procter are appointed to prepare & produce to a future sitting of the committee an Essay of a communication to the committee on Indian Concerns of Ohio and Indiana yearly Meetings - explanatory to them of what has been done by us in reference to the funds in the hands of Philip E. Thomas & Isaac Tyson.

Then adjourned to meet at the house of Hugh Balderson on the afternoon of the Quarterly meeting in the 6th month next at 5 O'clock.
