The Committee on Indian Concerns appointed  
by the Yearly Meeting at Battenville and the Yearly Meeting  
for the State of Ohio having by a Solemn engagement agreed  
to unite their future efforts to promote the Civilization  
and instruction of our Indian neighbours and appointed  
the undersigned to visit the Settlements heretofore under the  
care of friends, with a view of ascertaining the actual  
situation and present disposition of these Indians we  
~~left~~<sup>left</sup> ~~on~~<sup>on</sup> Start. out on the 18<sup>th</sup> of the 6<sup>th</sup> Month &  
proceeded to the residence of John Johnson the United States  
agent, and after some conference with him we pursued  
our journey accompanied by him and arrived at Hains  
Bank Kaunder on the 25<sup>th</sup> of the same month, we were  
soon after our arrival at this village visited by Boya-  
chickaw (the wolf) a principal chief and conducted  
to his cabin, where we arranged with him the appoint-  
ment of a council which was fixed to take place on the  
next morning and the same agrees as follows attended  
by all the chiefs of this village ~~and~~ and others  
Chattawee Redaw or Black Hoof  
Boyanchickaw and the wolf were seated on  
Pompsay Waller in the middle  
Cheemangatog " Big Snake  
Othawachickaw " Yellow feather  
Luitawaway " Head Warachit or Black snake  
& Chakalowway " the Concillor
