The Committee on Indian Concerns appointed by the Yearly Meeting at Bathing and the Yearly Meeting for the State of Ohio having by a later arrangement agreed to unite their future efforts to promote the civilization and instruction of our Indian neighbours and appointed the undersigned to visit the Settlement heretofore under the care of friends, with a view of ascertaining the actual situation and present disposition of these Indians on ^{the}~~the~~ ~~the~~ Short Creek on the 18th of the 6th month & proceeded to their residence of John Johnson the United States agent, and ~~afterwards~~ conference with him, and pursued our journey accompanied by him and arrived at Hauhaukannutaw on the 25th of the same month, we were shown after our arrival at this village visited by Boyanchickaw (the wolf) a principal chief and conducted to his Cabin, where we arranged with him the appointment of a Council which was fixed to take place on the next morning, at 10 o'clock. The same day was attended by all the chiefs of this Village.
