~~proceeded~~ ^{left} ~~on the 18th of the 6th month~~ ^{on the 18th of the 6th month}
 proceeded to the residence of John Johnson the United States
 agent, and ~~after a conference~~ ^{after a conference} with him ~~and~~ ^{and} pursued
 our journey accompanied by him and arrived at Nan-
 panawilla on the 25th of the same month, we were
 soon after our arrival in this village visited by Boya-
 chickaw (the wolf) a principal chief and conducted
 to his Cabin, where we arranged with him the appoint-
 ment of a Council which was fixed to take place on the
 next morning, and at the time agreed on was attended
 by all the chiefs of this Village.
