

to give any attention to their individual concerns
it was however hoped that this excitement would
only be of a temporary duration and that in
a little time the Indians at our settlement
would return to their domestic avocations
which they had for a considerably almost wholly neglected
The Committee had since their last

report rec'd a very pressing solicitation from
a settlement of Shawanese
Indians situated on the Anglaise river at
Maupakaunnetta to extend some assistance
to them, and had appointed a deputation
for the purpose of visiting them and ascertain-
ing their disposition, but the visit has not
yet been made, they had ~~been~~ ~~intended~~ some
assistance in tools and implements of husbandry
had been extended
to a village of Delawareans settled upon a
reservation on the Muskingum river

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1811 The Committee reported that the war did not
yet appear to open to renew its efforts at the settlement
on the Wabash as the minds of the Indians there and
through the surrounding Country still continued to
be greatly agitated by the religious depredations which
had been excited amongst them, The contemplated visit

had made to the village at Maupakaunnetta
and these Indians were found ^{to be} in a very satis-
=factory disposition of mind and anxiously dis-
=posed to receive aid from friends, and particularly
to be assisted in putting up a grist and saw mill
at their village, the committee had accordingly
concluded to ~~assist~~ aid them in the erection of
a grist mill which was now building under
the superintendence and care of one of its
members, some ^{further} assistance had also been furnished
to the Delawareans on the Muskingum near Rock-
=ken Johns Lake and a young man had been
employed several months at their Towns, to aid
them in preparing their tools & putting in their
crops

1812 The committee reported that this mill
at Maupakaunnetta ^{had been} ~~was~~ so far completed as to
commence grinding & had given general satisfaction
to the Indians. but that owing to the unhappy occur-
=ances which had occurred in that Country from the
war ~~which~~ now raging there, it was ^{not} deemed prudent
