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to send any person out ^{last spring} to reside at the settle-
ment ~~last spring~~, and that, the situation of these ^{Indians}
had recently become so critical that the Government
has resolved as an ^{indispensable} means of security to them, to
remove the whole of their families within
the ^{white} settlements where they ^{are now} supported at the
public expense, and their towns ^{are} ~~is~~ deserted.

The Committee has since last year continued to
care to the Delawareans near Mohrcken Johns Lake and
these Indians. ~~in the early part of the season, some~~
~~had~~ appeared disposed steadily to pursue the
improvement & cultivation of their land and there
appeared a good prospect of their making considerable
advances in the arts of civil life, they were accord-
ingly furnished with some wheat for the purpose
of sowing, last fall, but ^{such was} owing to the exasperated
state of the public mind throughout that country
that these villages had been entirely destroyed, and
the Indians obliged to fly for shelter & protection
to the Gov^t of the State of Ohio. The Committee also
~~have rec^d~~ the ^{distressing} intelligence, that the ~~settle-~~
ment which Friends had heretofore occupied

on the Wabash, ^{had been broken up} and the whole of the houses
burnt ~~and~~ the inhabitants dispersed or killed, ~~and~~
under these discouraging circumstances the Committee
~~has~~ found itself under the necessity of suspending
its labours at that place.

1813 The Committee reported that information
had been rec^d by them that several of the
Indian families had rec^d to Traupakannetta
there was a prospect that they would raise
and ~~had raised~~ a good crop of corn. The Committee
had however not resumed their operations except
that they had furnished a quantity of farming
tools to the settlement of Mingos situated on
the head waters of ~~the~~ Great Miami river near
Stoney Creek who had through their chief
~~made~~ application to friends for some agri-
-culture.

1814 The Committee reported that no way
appeared yet to open to resume ~~their~~ ^{its} operations
amongst the Indians. the late war which unhappily
raged through that country having only within
few months subsided and many of those people
