

At a meeting of the Executive Committee of the Baltimore Association held 6/17/82 present F. J. King, F. White, Jesse Lyson, Dr. Jas. Cary Thomas & John C. Thomas.

F. J. King informed the Committee that Allen Jay & himself had secured funds amounting to \$21,159. towards the enlargement & reorganization of New Garden School. He further stated that some of the large subscriptions were specially made upon condition that an endowment fund of \$10,000. be reserved from the funds collected -

F. J. King & Dr. J. C. Thomas were appointed to visit N. Carolina & confer with the Trustees of the Boarding School with reference to the enlargement of the present building, and the alteration of the Yearly Meeting House into an Academic building; also as to the reservation of \$10,000. as a permanent Endowment Fund.

F. J. King & Dr. Jas. C. Thomas reported that they met the Trustees of N. Garden Boarding School 3rd day, 6 Mo. 27th at New Garden & that the following arrangements were unanimously agreed upon, viz. that \$10,000. be reserved as a permanent Endowment Fund under a Trust with the Provident Life & Trust Co. of Philada. or such other Trust Co. at the North as may be agreed upon. They also united with the proposal of N. Carolina Yearly Meeting that that Yearly Meeting be held in future at a suitable place upon the through-line R. R. —

Also —
That the ^{present} Yearly Meeting House be converted into an Academic building, & that the suitable changes be made in the old School building. Their action was approved of,
