

This Indenture made the Fifteenth day of Fifth
Month A.D. One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy One
Between Francis T. King of Baltimore and Samuel
Bewley of Dublin, of the First Part. and the Provident
Life and Trust Company of Philadelphia of the Second
Part; - Whereas Joseph S. Richardson late of Waterford
Ireland deceased, in and by his last Will and Testament, dated
the Tenth day of April A.D. 1869 duly proved and registered, did
bequeath as follows "I leave the sum of Five Hundred
Pounds for the use and benefit of the friends of North Carolina
Yearly Meeting and a like sum for the use and benefit of the
colored freedmen of North America to be applied as
Francis T. King of Baltimore and Samuel Bewley of
Dublin or their survivors may appoint, provided my Exe-
cutor does not know of a better channel of appropriation
And Whereas the said two sums of Five Hundred
pounds Sterling each were paid over by the Executors of
said Will to the said Francis T. King and Samuel
Bewley who for the purpose of securing the appropriation
of the said Legacies to the uses and purposes of said
Will, have deemed it expedient and desirable to place
the said Funds with "The Provident Life and Trust
Company of Philadelphia" In Trust to apply the same
under the appointment and direction of them the said
Francis T. King and Samuel Bewley as hereinafter
expressed - Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the
said parties of the first part in Execution of the power in
them vested as aforesaid have put and placed and hereby
