They agree to the proposition which we understand to be \$600 are to be paid out for 50 acres land & dwelling at Mt. Pleasant one half to be contributed by John Muth & the other half by our Ass^o, in the name of Isaac Tyeon, the property to be held jointly & Mr Richardson is to have the use free of rent or interest for 3 years, with the privilege of his buying the property for \$600 at any time during the 3 years.

If the property should be sold at the expiration of 3 years the profit or loss as the case may be shall be equally divided between said John Muth & I. Any improvements or costs beyond the said \$600 attending the purchase or improvement of the property is to be borne by said Richardson, and to be chargeable to the property.
