

1865-12th Mo 23rd

Arrived in Greensborough on Sunday night at half ^{past} nine. went to a public house & spent the night. First day Morning raining fast. I started out & found Dr L. W. C. Benbow, & a man who kept a stage, engaged a horse & buggy to go New Garden to meeting. it however continued to rain so fast we concluded not to go until after dinner. Dr Benbow called ^{on} us, and invited us to dine with ^{him}, which we did. after dinner we made another attempt rode about two miles to a stream of water which was too high to ford. So we had to return to town again.

Second day 25th We succeeded to day in getting to New Garden delivered to John Carter a letter which ^{was} ~~we~~ trusted to my care. & dined with them at the boarding school. They have some fifty fine scholars at present we left after dinner for Daniel Barkers, having also a letter for him, which I delivered. we spent the night with him. we left on ^{the} morning 26th and called to see Delphina & Mendenhall. we conversed with each of the above named friends in relation to the establishment of schools among friends, returned to Greensborough and made arrangements with David
