

we did not visit any of these schools they had been furnished with books by J. and by Warner

15th Rode to Rocky river part of Pine Creek. Mr. Mtz visited a school taught by Mary Cox numbering some 60 scholars or 47 children within the limits of Rocky river preparation meeting. Mary conducted her school very well. we spent some time with her.

16th visited a school in Pine Creek. Mtz have taught by Mahlon Dickson, who had on his list sixty three 37 members & 26 not members. who reported 75 children of friends within the limits of this preparation. Mtz we spent some time in this school. which was handsomely conducted both in system & order. The teachers thinks this school will sustain itself.

17 attended Spring Meeting where there was four men & one woman in attendance. we consulted with those friends in relation to schools. & as informed us there was about thirty children within the limits of this Mtz and there was one school kept by a young woman but could not inform of the number. we had not time to visit it at present

18th Returned to Greensboro found letters from home also more goods & from Baltimore & letters.

19th After attending to such business as required our attention we left in the eve for Jamestown in order to attend the Deep river Quarterly Mtz which we did & saw the committee who informed us they would not ^{be ready} to open their school until the first of the third Mo they requested ^{me} to get a teacher from the north I have written to one

23rd I left for H. Garden School assisted in getting ^{up} two stoves one in the dining room & one in the girls school room

24th attended their week day Mtz left after dinner for Elisha Standen hall on way to Deep Creek. Elisha was to accompany me. but was too unwell.

25th Left alone having sent Joseph to examine schools with in Centre & Northborough. Mr. Mtz rode 25 miles to Porters to the house of Isaac Hatches.

26th Rode to Hunting Creek 18 miles 27th Held a conference with a few of the Mr. Mtz committee in relation to schools here. they have no house but talk of building one
