

First day 11th Attended the public Meeting at Cane Creek to day which was large supposed to be not less than 500 persons present, Joseph & myself were both engaged in our Masters Service May a blessing attend this opportunity.

12th I left our dear friends Isham Cox & family this morning for Greensboro, leaving Joseph to visit a School at Rocky river, Stopped in the neighborhood of Centre at the Widow Coxs, where Son Isaac is one of the Mc Mtgo committee for Centre Meeting. I requested him to be careful, and ascertain if the Schools does not sustain themselves to inform Joseph Moore and he will give some assistance.

13 Joseph Moore informed me ^{he} visited the School at Rocky river taught by Martha Kemp who is a ^{member} and all the scholars eleven on the list, all as we understand in limited circumstances we provided her one dollar per month for each child Joseph gave 10 lbs

Gave to Isham Cox for Mary Hodgins 13 1/2 yds of Calico 7 1/2 yds grey flannel 2 lb muslin 2 Doy Hookers 1 Spool Colored cotton also 1 vest for M Hobson

I also gave Isham Cox for their two libraries in the of Cane Creek Monthly Meeting Six Abriah Nov, Six Godmans Prambles, Six Scripture Lessons, Six Youthful Pilgrims, Six George Doves Epistles, Six William Penns Memoir Six Pinnington Letters, with some tracts,

I rode to New Garden this morning to inform John Carter of the arrival of the Shingles to cover the School house while their Spurchand his grey mare pany for Joseph Moore to use also bought a killer saddle pany for the mare one hundred & twenty five dollars and for the bridle & saddle fifteen dollars.

I was called on to day by Joshua Linsby a consistent member of Society and made known his destitute situation though he owns a ^{new} farm he has nothing to live on I gave him ten dollars, wrote to F D King giving a statement of his condition. He wishes them to furnish him with five barrels flour & four hundred lbs of bacon which would be sufficient to carry him and his family through the year.
