L. has had the comfort of leading many of her scholars to the Saviour. One young man who had always laughed at religion was so impressed by her teachings that he sought & found forgiveness of his sins, and is now an earnest, active helper in the work. We have always paid more attention to religious teaching; education being used as a means of enlightening those who were drawn to Christ. We hope to be able to continue the work another year."
