

At a meeting for Sufferings, held in
Baltimore on the 18th day of 10th mo 1851

Present 24 Members, also several
brethren from other yearly meetings,
whose company is acceptable

A minute was received and read
from Baltimore Quarterly Meeting
informing us that ^{they} had appointed
Isaac Hoge one of their representatives
in this meeting in the place of Robert
Bond deceased. His name is directed
to be placed upon our list of Members

The Committee to procure and circulate
copies of certain standard Books (named in
the report), among our members and others,
made the following report, which is satis-
factory and the Committee is continued
to the meeting for Sufferings,

"Since our report in the 10th month last year
but few sales of Books have been made the
demand having very much diminished

The number of Books on hand & unsold is

The balance of cash on hand at this time is \$19.33
The sum of \$83 was obtained from the Treasurer
of the Yearly Meeting as authorized to aid the
Committee in making purchases, no part of this
sum has been returned & no other indebtedness
stands against the Book account

the 13th of 3rd mo 1852 present 14 members.
