Conveys a certain tract of land, being a
 part of a tract called Elberton, lying on
 the South side of the great road, leading
 from John Charles dwelling house to Stafford
 and beginning for the same at a stone
 marked No 1. Sit at the End of Sixty two
 and a half perches North 76^o East from
 a stone on the road immediately before
 John Charles door where the road from
 Darlington, Wilsons Mill, and Stafford
 all unite, and running thence North
 and one half East nine perches to a
 stone marked No 2, thence North Nor-
 easterly Six and a half East nine
 perches to a stone marked No 3, thence
 North 13^o West 9 perches to a stone
 marked No 4, thence to the place of be-
 ginning - Containing half an acre of land -
 To be held by the above named Trustees and
 their Successors and assigns or such
 other persons as Deer Creek Monthly

Meeting may from time to time appear
 for the special use and benefit of the Society
 of Friends or the members thereof in ses-
 sion Composing and belonging to
 Deer Creek Monthly Meeting in unity
 with the adjacent Yearly Meetings of
 Friends.

Conveys part of tract called Elberton, beginning
 in middle of County road near Darlington lead-
 ing from Charles Corner to Monson Corner
 said point being North 11^o West 15 ft from
 a stone marked D on the South side of said
 road and running with the middle of said
 road North 49^o E 3¹/₁₀₀ perches to the corner
 of the old church lot, thence bounding on
 the five following lines of said lot South
