Conveys - that certain lot of land Sit-
 uate in Loudoun County Va near Silent
 Springs, being a part of the land of the
 said grantor bounded and described as
 follows: - Beginning at a point in the
 Silent Springs road where it intersects the
 road from Snickersville to Purcellville
 thence along the middle of said road South
 85¹/₂° West 16.96 poles to a corner in the
 middle of said road, thence South 4¹/₂° East
 8.62 poles to a corner in the field - thence
 South 58° East 8.84 poles to a corner
 in the middle of the road from Silent
 Springs to Purcellville, thence with its
 middle North 31¹/₂° East 17.38 poles to the
 place of beginning Containing 150 Square
 perches of land More or Less -

B "In Trust for the Society of Friends in unity
 with the latest yearly Meeting of
 Friends worshipping at Silent Springs
 Loudoun Co Va in which a house has
 been erected to be used as a place of
 meeting and to be subject to the discipline
 and under the control of the Baltimore
 Monthly Meeting of Friends for the Eastern
 and Western Districts from which a portion
 of the money has been furnished to erect
 said Meeting house - but it is expressly
 provided under bond and agreed that if
 said house should at any future time
 be abandoned and not longer used
 for a reasonable length of time as
 a place of meeting and worship by
 the members of the aforesaid Society
 then and in that event the said land shall
 revert and return to the said grantor his
 heirs and assigns - but the aforesaid
 Society shall have the right to sell
 and dispose of all buildings erected
 thereon here before or here after unless
 the said grantor will compensate the
 said Society for the then value of said
 buildings at such price as may be
 agreed on or as determined by parties, may
 award is then fair value under existing
 circumstances -
