Recites Deed of July 10th 1882 from R. A. Bristol
to said Trustee of lot in Southampton Co. Con-
taining one acre, for "Round Hill Church - that
the real purpose, object and design of said
Conveyance was to convey said property to the
said parties of the second part in trust for
the members of the Religious Society of
of Friends in unity with the Ancient Yearly
Meeting of Friends, worshipping at Cornish
Southampton County Va. to erect a house
thereon as a place of worship and the
same has since said conveyance been so
used and enjoyed."

That the real object purpose and design
of said conveyance and the trusts intended
thereby were not clearly in said deed.

That a recent survey has been made
of said tract by J. C. Mills Surveyor whereby
the metes and bounds of said lot were as-
certained to be as follows:

Beginning at an Iron post on the Berlin
and Blackwater Road and said post being

at the South East Corner of said lot; thence
bounding on said road. South 88° West $222\frac{3}{4}$
feet to a Pig Iron Post; thence North
 1° West $221\frac{3}{4}$ feet with the other land of
said R. A. Bristol to a Pine Tree about
sixteen inches in diameter; thence North
 89° East $183\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a white Oak tree about
five inches in diameter, thence with the land of
said George W. Raiford South 72° East $93\frac{3}{4}$
feet to a Black Gum about seven inches in
diameter; thence South $13\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East $123\frac{3}{4}$ feet
to the place of beginning, Containing one
and two hundredths (1.02) acres, as more
fully appear from the above said survey, to be
the same more or less."

That it is the desire of the parties to carry
out the original purpose and intent of
of the deed of July 10th 1882

Conveys in Consideration of promises and
the sum of \$5 - the above said lot to the
parties of second part and their successors
as Trustees.

In Trust nevertheless for the members of
the Religious Society of Friends in unity
with the Ancient Yearly Meeting of Friends
worshipping at Cornish Southampton Co.
Virginia and the house which has been
erected thereon with any other what may
