Conveys all that certain Messuage & tenement
 & lot of ground situate in East St. Clair
 Township, County and State aforesaid
 (Bedford Co. Penna), North of Fiskerton
 bounded and described as follows - Beginning
 at a Stone on the East Side of the Valley
 Road, thence by said Road North 10° East
 12¹/₂ perches to a Stone, thence by land
 of Thomas & Co. Coy South 75° East 6¹/₂ perches
 to a Stone, thence South 10° West 12¹/₂ perches
 to a Stone, thence North 75° West 6¹/₂ perches
 to the place of beginning, Containing
 Twenty Eight perches more or less
 To Have and to Hold the said above
 described lot of ground unto the said
 Thomas E. Miller and John E. Davis and
 to their heirs according to the Course of
 the Common Law and then assigns in
 Trust nevertheless to and for the use
 benefit and advantage of the Religious
 Society of people called Quakers be-
 longing to Dunning's Creek Monthly
 Meeting, held at Dunning's Creek in

the Township, County and State aforesaid
 in perpetual succession for ever -
 Provision for removal of bushes, and
 appointment of road on Dunning's
 Creek Monthly Meeting, similar to clause
 in Deed from Jane W. Brown to
 Jacobus & Co. of Curwensville
 Meeting house property - (see page 85 ante)
 It is also provided that no part of the
 aforesaid mentioned plot of ground shall ever
 be used for a place of burial -
