To the Permanent Board of Baltimore Yearly Meeting:--

The Committee on Titles to Meeting House Properties has given some attention to the subject of their appointment, but have no definite report at present to make relative to correcting errors which seem to them to exist in certain titles. They will hope to make a full report on this subject to a later meeting. Under the minute of the Board authorizing same, they have paid the following premiums for insurance on properties:

Two-thirds premium on Corinth School for three years	\$20.00
Entire premium on Corinth Meeting House for three years (this premium to be returned to the Yearly Meeting when collected by the Local Meeting)	24.00
Entire premium for three years on Fishertown Meeting House	13.80
Entire premium on Curwensville Meeting House	13.00

As at present advised, all of the Meeting House properties are now insured, with the exception of the Hopewell Meeting House. As our interest in this property is very doubtful and as same is held in common with the friends of the other branch, it is a question whether any insurance could be placed on the property, in any event by our Meeting.
