A special meeting of the Permanent Board of Baltimore Yearly Meeting of Friends (Orthodox) was held at the Irving Street Meeting House, Washington, D. C. on 1/13/40 at 5 p.m. There was a highly gratifying response to the special summons, seventeen members being present.

July J. Hoge Ricks read an invitation to the General Conference of Friends to be held at Cape May, New Jersey, from July 8th to 15th, 1940. It was decided that any one able to attend should notify J. Hoge Ricks in order to receive the proper credentials.

The Board authorized the purchase of William Wade Hinshaw's book on the New York Yearly Meeting, costing twelve dollars.

After long and earnest discussion it was decided not to ~~revise~~ the budget adopted by the Finance Committee, but to notify the Treasurer of the Five Years Meeting that, owing to the death of a generous contributor to our Meeting, we might be unable to raise the full amount of money, \$3500, due the United Budget altho' we shall make a determined effort to do so.
