A stated meeting of the Permanent Board of Baltimore Yearly Meeting (Orthodox) was held at Homewood on 10/23/42, nine members being present.

The minutes of the preceding meeting were read and approved.

A request from Paul D. Woodard, Treas., of the Richmond Monthly Meeting, for a renewal for another year of a loan of \$2500⁰⁰ @ 3% was approved.

A communication from the Washington Monthly Meeting regarding a special assessment levied by the District of Columbia, for improvements on 13th St. N.W., was read. It was decided by the Permanent Board to authorize the Baltimore Yearly Meeting to bear one half of this tax, the total amount of the assessment being \$217.⁹⁰

The Records Committee was granted an appropriation of fifty dollars to cover various expenses: for rebinding books; for the purchase of a Transcript of Virginia Yearly Meeting minutes (1702-1724); and thirteen Old Epistles; also for the purchase of records of the Virginia Yearly Meeting (1737-1758), in the form of a Photostat, the original books being in private hands.

The Clerk was instructed to advise the Yearly Meeting of the expiration of the term of service of the following members of the Permanent Board: Mordecai T. Funnell, Edmund C. Stanton, E. H. Haviland, Lindsay E. Parker, Edith H. S. Silver, Jane D. P. White, Charles E. Neave.

The Patuxent Meeting having been laid down, the Permanent Board appointed

R. Ernest Neave to be custodian of the property, assisted by the following Committee in the matter of repairs and insurance: Thomas H. Y. Clark, J. Edgar Hiatt, and R. Ernest Neave.

The following Memorials were read to the Permanent Board:

Jeptha V. Hare
and

Hunter D. Raiford.

The Board instructed the Clerk to forward these memorials to the Yearly Meeting to be read in the current session, and to record our appreciation of the lives and services of our departed Friends.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
