A stated meeting of the Permanent Board of Baltimore Yearly Meeting was held at Stony Run Meeting House, eleven members being present.

The Memorial of Albert Simon was received from the Clerk of Hornewood Monthly Meeting and was read to the Board, who directed the Clerk of the Board to forward the Memorial to the Clerk of the Yearly Meeting with the request it be read to the Meeting in the following day's session. The Permanent Board instructed its Clerk to admonish the Clerks of the various Monthly Meetings to follow the prescribed routine of forwarding communications to the Quarterly Meetings, who in turn may then pass them along to the Yearly Meeting.

The Memorial of Linnie Raiford Neave was read to the Board, the Clerk being ordered to forward it to the Clerk of the Yearly Meeting with the recommendation that it be read in ^{the} session of the following day.

J. Hoge Ricks reported that the Richmond Monthly Meeting has sold a lot for \$750 less the commission.

Harry Wellons informed the Board of some improvements made in the Black Creek Meeting House during 1950.

The Clerk was instructed to make a minute concerning the sale of the Deer Creek Meeting House in 1951, at the time of the consolidation of the two Meetings.

Somerton Monthly Meeting reported the acquisition of two acres of land and the building of a Community House.

The Board ordered the Clerk to make a survey of the Insurance carried by the various Monthly Meetings and at the same time to bring to their attention the fact that the cost of building materials having advanced the expense of rebuilding or restoration following a fire would be much greater than was formerly the case. ^{Caleb Winslow was appointed Clerk for another term.} This concluded the business.
