He did not stand alone, but he stood out as a leader. After many years as Clerk of the Monthly Meeting, when he stepped down from that office we knew that the one to take his place would have a real challenge before him. The passing of Clarence J. Robinson leaves one with the thought; "maybe I should do more to help."

We are saddened by his departure - yet we rejoice that he has heard his Heavenly Father's welcome, "Well done, thou good and faithful servant. Enter thou into the joy of Thy Lord." When he left this life he took with him a personality that cannot be replaced, but will always be remembered.
