Emmet Manly Frazer

Emmet Manly Frazer was born at Oakland Mills, Iowa, May 24, 1903, the son of Manly G. Frazer and Jessie E. Young Frazer. He passed away suddenly on July 9, 1962, and was laid to rest in Friends' Section, Hollywood Cemetery, Richmond, Virginia.

He was graduated from ~~William~~ Penn College, Oskaloosa, Iowa in 1926, and received his master degree in religion from Duke University, Durham, North Carolina, in 1938.

He married Ava Fish in Oskaloosa, Iowa, August 25, 1927. To this union was born a son who died in infancy, and a daughter Jessie Ava Frazer. He is survived by his wife, his daughter and two grand-daughters.

He became a Friend while attending Penn College and transferred his membership to Richmond Monthly Meeting in 1929. He immediately became active in the local meeting, where he continued to serve in many capacities for the rest of his life. He was recorded as a minister in the Society of Friends in November 1929. He participated actively in many Quaker activities and projects in the monthly, quarterly, yearly and five years meetings. He served as Clerk of Baltimore Yearly Meeting from 1953 to 1959, and as a member of the Executive Committee of the Five Years Meeting from 1955 to 1960. At the time of his
