The following annual report was made:

To the Permanent Board of the Baltimore Yearly Meeting of Friends:

In accordance with their Act of Incorporation, the Trustees of the Thos. King Benevolent Association of Darlington, Md. make this, their 72nd report:

In July, 1957, the investment of the King Fund money needed to be changed. The bonds then held became due; the amount was four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00). Thomas W. Y. Clark was asked to handle the matter and did so most satisfactorily. Five (5) new bonds, Washington Sub. San. Dist. Md., were purchased for \$3,953.95 with

The difference between the sale of the old bonds and the purchase of the new bonds amounted to twenty-five dollars and eighty-one cents (\$25.81). This amount was deposited in the checking account of the King Fund.

The five new bonds have coupons attached to be clipped June 1st and December 1st. They have been placed in the safe deposit box of C. Edgar Thomas in the Commercial and Savings Bank of Bal Air, Md.

Help has been given in the neighborhood as follows: Two needy families were given food and fuel. One aged woman was given one ton of coal.
