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Certificate of Incorporation: of the

The undersigned Francis White, and James Cary, residents of Baltimore County, and Francis J. King, Caleb Winslow, and Joseph P. Elliott, residents of Baltimore City, all of them being citizens of the State of Maryland, and citizens of the United States, are desirous of forming a Corporation for educational, charitable and beneficial purposes: and do therefore, by virtue of, and in conformity with the enabling provisions of the Code of Public Laws of the State of Maryland, in force for that purpose, sign, seal and acknowledge this Certificate in writing of the formation of said Corporation.

Article I. Name.

The name of this Corporation shall be the "Miles White Beneficial Society of Baltimore City."

Article II. Objects.

The objects of this Corporation shall be to promote piety and Christianity (especially by the dissemination of books and tracts), to extend aid to the young in their religious, moral and intellectual training and education, and to relieve the deserving poor.

Article III. Powers.

This Corporation shall be competent to receive and hold and use for the purposes for which it is created, in manner and form as may be prescribed from time to time, by its By-Laws,
