

and Resolutions, gifts, devises and bequests of property, real and personal of every description.

Article IV. Duration.

The duration of this Corporation shall be, as limited by law, forty years: but as it is the intention of its framers to extend its beneficial purposes, and results if possible indefinitely, it is created subject to such Laws as may hereafter be made enabling the existence of the Corporation, and the continuance of its benefits to extend beyond that period.

Article V. Location

The operations of this Corporation are to be carried on in the State of Maryland: and the principal office of the Corporation will be located in the City of Baltimore.

Article VI. Trustees.

The business of this Corporation shall be managed by seven Trustees. And the trustees who shall manage said business for the first year shall be Francis White, James Carey, and Miles White, Junior of Baltimore County: Francis I. King, Caleb Winslow, and Joseph P. Elliott of Baltimore City, in the State of Maryland and Francis S. White of the City of Cincinnati in the State of Ohio: and the said Trustees and their successors to be appointed in the manner required by law shall continue at all times hereafter to manage the business of this Corporation.

Article VII. Annual Reports.

The Board of Trustees of this Corporation shall

annually make a written statement of its operations and of the disposition and condition of its finances for the preceding year, and submit the same to the "Baltimore Yearly Meeting of Friends" in unity with the "Ancient Yearly Meeting of Friends", or to such "Yearly Meeting," as the "Friends" of Baltimore may hereafter be attached to.
