The Educational Committee reported in favor of appropriating \$200 for the education of Thos W. Winslow at Haverford College for the ensuing year provided he makes sufficient improvement, also to allow Bettie Ball to continue Bettie Bradshaws unexpired term if it entails no additional expense.

The meeting after adopting said report adjourned.
