At a Monthly meeting of the Miles White Beneficial Society held 4th mo. 13th 1881, F. White, President, F. F. King, Jas. Carey, Jos. P. Elliott, Dr. C. Winslow and M. White, Jr. were present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read, and adopted.

The Finance Committee reported that acting under authority of power given them 5th mo. 3rd 1880, they had bought \$25,000 Northern Pacific 3% Bonds @ 102 and accrued interest, and proposed to call in the loan to Newcomer & Co. and invest the balance of it in them also, making a total of \$28,000. Unanimously agreed to.

The Educational Committee recommended appropriating \$100 to Southland College Arkansas and the Charity Committee recommended the following appropriations.
