The last mentioned sum has been returned and \$28,000 of Northern Pacific Rail Road Bonds bearing 6% Interest have been purchased.

The 5% Government Bonds were called in by the Government for payment or continuance of Interest at the rate of 3 1/2 % per annum. Ours were continued at the reduced rate of Interest.

Elliott Treasurer, be and is hereby authorized to sell or assign thirty thousand (\$30,000) Dollars 5% Funded Loan 1881, continued at 3 1/2 % United States Bonds registered in the name of The Miles White Beneficial Society of Baltimore City, Md. on the books of the Treasury Department, with power to appoint one or more substitutes for the
