Upon motion of Jos P. Elliott it was unanimously resolved That Francis T. White be and is hereby authorized to sell or assign \$20,000 of the Loan July 14, 1870 & Jan 20, 1871 commonly known as 4% Consols 1907 United States Bonds registered in the

name of Miles White Beneficial Society of Baltimore Md, on the books of the Treasury Department with power to appoint one or more substitutes for the purposes herein expressed, until such authority is officially revoked and notice of revocation is properly given to the Treasury Department.

It was also unanimously resolved upon motion of F. T. King to purchase \$25,000 1st Mortgage 5% Bonds of Little Miami L.R Co at 103 and interest.
