Dear Friends,

The Trustees of the Miles & White Beneficial Society in conformity with its Act of Incorporation submit the following statement of its operations

for the past year.

They have thought best to set aside annually an amount to offset the decline of premiums on securities held, as they mature; and to provide for the purchase of others in their stead; and accordingly have, during the past year purchased \$500 of the Virginia Midland R.R. 5th Series 5% bonds at a cost of \$506 ²⁵/₁₀₀. Otherwise there has been no change made in the investments.

Interest to the amount of \$5330 has been received; of which \$4476 has been distributed as follows: \$2525 for Charitable objects, \$1070 for Educational purposes, and \$581 for the dissemination of Books & Tracts.
