To Baltimore Yearly Meeting of Friends.
Dear Friends:

The Trustees of the Miles White Beneficial Society in conformity with its Act of Incorporation submit the following statement of its operations for the past year.

In thus doing they are called upon to announce the great loss they have sustained in the death of their late co-trustee Francis J. King, who was always in sympathy with the objects of the Society, and whose excellent judgment was conscientiously exercised in administering the trust committed to their charge. Francis A. White of Baltimore has been elected to fill the vacancy thus caused in the Board.

Since our last report there has been purchased one Cincinnati Lebanon & Northern Railroad 5% Bond of \$1000 at a cost of \$1019⁹⁴.

Otherwise there has been no change made in the investments.

Interest to the amount of \$5388⁰² has been received, and \$4668⁶⁵ has been distributed as follows: \$2748¹⁵ for charitable objects, \$1245⁵⁰ for educational purposes, \$425 for dissemination of books and tracts, and \$250 has been advanced as a loan for educational purposes.
