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Since the last Report there has been no change made in the investments of the Society.

Interest to the amount of \$5568⁵⁰/₁₀₀ has been received, and \$4745⁷⁵/₁₀₀ has been distributed as follows: \$2653⁴⁹/₁₀₀ for charitable objects; \$1543⁷⁶/₁₀₀ for educational purposes; \$441⁰⁰/₁₀₀ for dissemination of books and tracts, and \$107⁵⁰/₁₀₀ has been advanced to two deserving persons as loans for educational purposes.
