The Finance Committee reported that one Northern Pacific R.R. 1st Mortgage Bond had been called for redemption and paid off last July and that they had purchased \$1000 of Charlotte Columbia and Augusta R.R. 1st Mty & extended 5th Bond

at 108  $\frac{1}{2}$ , and the action of the Committee was unanimously satisfied. The same Committee further reported that the Society now holds \$106,000 par value of R.R. Bonds standing in its books at \$107,939  $\frac{1}{2}$  which are worth at present market prices over \$118,000  $\frac{1}{2}$ .

A report was received from Southland College showing that the money granted it last year had been used to educate 10 students.

A report was received from Cedar Grove Prep. Mty School N.C. showing that money granted it last year had been used to pay entire tuition of 5 scholars and part tuition of 7 others.

A report received from Eastern St. Mty School at Belvidere N.C. showed that part of tuition of 20 scholars during one term had been paid by money granted in Nov. 1894.

A report received from Aurora Academy N.C. showed that money granted it had been used as follows: Tuition of needy friends children \$27  $\frac{1}{2}$ , tuition of 1 scholar not a friend \$1  $\frac{1}{2}$ , Teacher of Primary Dept (her whole pay) \$21  $\frac{1}{2}$ .

Pres. L. L. Hobbs reported that D. Gilbert Thompson would not need loan this term & perhaps not this year.
