A report was received from White Plains School N.C. showing that 46 children had been assisted from the \$50 granted the School.

Richd C. Congdon asked for a further loan of \$400 to enable him to go to Leligh University for year 1898-99; \$60 (the paid) now and it was granted.

Elias G. Cook asked for a loan of \$100 for 1 year his brother to sign note, as well as himself and the loan was authorized.

An appropriation of \$100 was made to the W. Mass Christian Assoc to procure type writers.
