A report was received from Belvidere Academy N.C. showing that the \$100 granted it last year had been used to educate 18 students.

Cedar Grove Infantine School reported that the \$75 granted it last year was used to to extend the time the school was open so that an average attendance of 31 was secured for 6 months.

The \$75 granted to Aurora Academy Rich Square N.C. enabled the school to be held for 7 months with an enrollment of 80 and an average attendance of more than 60.
