Since the last report there has been no change made in the investments of the Society.

Interest to the amount of \$5.512 ²²/₁₀₀ has been received, and \$5.355 ²⁴/₁₀₀ have been distributed as follows: \$2250 for charitable objects; \$1,842 ⁹⁴/₁₀₀ for educational purposes; \$230 for the dissemination of books and tracts; \$603 ⁹³/₁₀₀ for taxes and incidental expenses; and \$428 ⁴⁷/₁₀₀ have been advanced to four deserving persons as loans for educational and other purposes.
