

and the loan authorized at the last meeting of the Board.

A report was received from Aurora High School NC stating that during past year the school was kept open seven months with an enrollment of 70 of whom 21 were friends and 32 others connected with friends. Average attendance after first six weeks 55 to 75 granted by this Society was used to extend the term after State aid was exhausted, patrons having contributed \$112 also to this purpose. The School has a library of between 400 and 500 volumes towards cost of which patrons contributed \$70=

Cedar Grove Prep. Htz School NC reported that \$75 granted last year was used to pay entire tuition 6 pupils and to assist 5 others and the balance used to lengthen term to 8 months enrollment 63 of whom 31 were friends, average attendance 40; received from State \$200, from Patrons \$70.

Belvidere Academy NC reported that \$100 granted last year had been used to assist 30 pupils and that this year the school has opened with a fuller attendance than usual.

J. H. Moore the retiring principal of Friendsville Academy NC reported that \$100 granted it last year had been used to assist three pupils for 2 terms and nine pupils for one term.

Samuel Dunlap Secy Board Managers Friendsville Academy forwarded a resolution of the Board of Managers tendering their thanks for last year's appropriation and asking for this year such sum as may seem right to us to set apart. With this resolution was the endorsement of Representatives of W.ilmington Yearly Mtg and also of the Yearly Meeting. S. Dunlap further stated that W.ilmington Mtg had appropriated \$100 to the Academy and he asked if we

could not give \$100=

The Board decided to limit this year's grant to the \$100 authorized at last meeting.
