Augusta Academy N.C. reported that only half of the \$75 appropriated to it last year had been used, the school only being carried on eleven weeks, the tuition of 5 children was paid entirely and 8 more partly, the balance of the grant will be used this autumn.

John C. Thomas made a report of the use made by him of the \$50 granted last year for relief of poor at Federal Hill showing that 10 persons were aided by 42 payments.
