From reports received from various schools named below it appears that
 Upper River School N.C. was maintained for 10 1/2 weeks at an expense of \$81 of which \$43 45 was provided by this Society \$8 by Tripp Fund and \$29 55 by Patrons.

Friendsville Academy during past year had an enrollment of 140, appropriations from all sources were used as a general tuition fund making the rate of tuition very low.

Charity Mission School was held for 10 weeks with an enrollment of 34 of whom 10 were Friends.

Cedar Grove Preparatory Meeting School was given a term of 7 months with an enrollment of 65 of whom 35 were Friends average attendance 45 receipts were from County \$200, from Patrons \$172 from M. W. for \$75.

Rocky River School N.C. was continued 2 months with an enrollment of 17 of whom 6 were Friends average attendance 12.
