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students; that it was hoped to add a new course in agriculture the coming year; that teachers had taken special training during the past summer, and the expense for the coming year would be greater than heretofore. That Belvidere Academy used our appropriation of \$100.00 in paying the salary of the teachers. That Guilford College used our appropriation of \$500.00 in aiding 56 worthy students. That Guilford Graded School used our appropriation of \$100.00 in prolonging the term. That Southland College used our appropriation of \$100.00 in aiding 9 worthy students and that the year had been very successful. That White Plains School used our appropriation of \$50.00 in maintaining the School for 65 children, and that the School had been doing good work, both for educating Friends' children and others. That our appropriation of \$250.00 to The American Friend had been used to extend the circulation of the Paper to most of those Members of Baltimore Yearly Meeting and many of those in North Carolina Meeting who are not already subscribers, Vincent Nicholson has been employed since June as Field Secretary, visiting the various Meetings and soliciting subscriptions. That our appropriation of \$100.00 to Blue Ridge Mission School had been used in carrying on the work of the School, that Joseph M. Purdie and wife were the teachers, and that improvement had been made both in the School and Meeting.

The Treasurer, in accordance with article 3 of the Bylaws, presented the following report, which was referred to the Finance Committee to be audited. (See opposite page). The Treasurer also reported the list of outstanding loans, which were in order, and reported that there were no changes in the Securities, but that three bonds of Buffalo & Susquehanna R. R. Co.
