Also that at the Annual Meeting of the American Friend
Publishing Company, held last week, it was reported that Vincent

which is in excess of his salary, and will remain in the field until
July.

In addition to the
regular contributions, the paper ran behind \$1200. during the past
year.

This amount will be endeavored to be offset by increased
advertisements the coming year.

A guarantee fund of \$2000.
has also been secured.

The usual appropriation of \$250. for
free distribution among members of Baltimore and North Carolina
Yearly Meetings, not subscribers, and to others is recommended.
