

That Friendsville Academy used our appropriation of \$100. together with assistance given by Wilmington Yearly Meeting, as a general tuition fund, which enables the Academy to maintain a low rate of tuition. During the term of 1910-1911, 125 pupils were enrolled and three teachers employed.

That West Union School of Rich Square, N. C. used our appropriation of \$100. toward paying the salary of one teacher in the fall, before the beginning of the free school, and toward paying the salaries of two teachers in the spring, the patrons paying the balance. More work has been done to improve the house and grounds during the past year.

That Guilford College used our appropriation of \$500. in aiding 61 worthy students.

That our appropriation of \$250. to The American Friend was used to extend the circulation of the paper to those members of Baltimore and North Carolina Yearly Meetings, not subscribers, and also to others. In addition to this appropriation which was essential, \$500. was given by special individual subscription.

Vincent Nicholson in the middle west and Raymond Williams on the Pacific Coast, have by canvassing, increased the subscriptions by over 700.

The Paper has improved and is felt by the Directors to be necessary for the welfare of Friends.
