SECRETARY'S REPORT-

Oct. 7-'18-

The appropriations for the past year have been about the same as usual, except no appropriation was made to Belvidere Academy this year.

White Plains School has become a County School, so they no longer need their usual appropriation.

We also added to our list last year, the High Point Normal and Industrial School, N. C. for colored boys.

The Free Summer Excursion Society were unable to obtain the ice boat for the summer, so returned our appropriation of \$25.00.

We have given appropriations to the Service Committee for practically each Monthly Meeting in Baltimore Yearly Meeting, for the purchase of materials for sewing (\$300.) which are of course, new appropriations. We have also appropriated \$100. towards the expenses of one of the members of the Reconstruction Unit.

The appropriation of \$200.00 for the American Friend has been used for the distribution of 100 copies of the Paper, to those who would not otherwise subscribe, largely in our own Meeting.
