

10/27/85. Committee Met - 14 members present.

The following questions were put by the Chairman and answered by a vote of the Committee as will appear.

1. Is it the duty of the subordinate meetings to supply educational facilities to their members?
Answer. Yes, as far as able.
2. Is it advisable for the Yearly Meeting to retain a Committee on Education?
Answer. Yes.
3. Should aid be extended until past receiving application for assistance from the Monthly Meeting within the limits of which the school is located?
Answer. No.
4. If the Yearly Meeting undertakes to raise money directly for educational purposes should it not be raised by apportionment on each Quarter as other Yearly Meeting funds?
Answer. Yes.

5. Should a definite sum of money for the use of this Committee be annually appropriated by the Yearly Meeting from its treasury?
Answer. No.

6. Should the Committee depend on help from voluntary subscriptions?
Answer. Yes.

On motion of Mr C Thomas the following resolution was adopted.

"We suggest that the Yearly Meeting appoint a Committee on Education composed of five men + five women friends from Baltimore Monthly Meeting, and at least one man + one woman friend from each of the other Monthly Meetings to confer with Committees of the General Monthly Meetings on the subject, and to receive whatever sums may be voluntarily contributed for the purpose, to be distributed, disbursed in accordance with the wish of the donors. - If given unconditionally they shall primarily be expended in the strengthening schools."
