

The Educational Committee met 1st Mo 16th 1899
 Miles White Jr. Katharine M. Brevitt Ellen A. Melanson
 John C. Thomas & Margaret S. Carey were present.
 The Com. to suggest a standard to which applicants
 for aid to go to college must attain reported
 that one meeting had been held and agreed
 that no requests should be sent to the Educational
 Committee until the pupil had gone as far as
 possible at the local school and had received
 a certificate from the teacher stating this
 and that he or she was a bright scholar.
 None were sent to boarding school who
 were not advanced beyond the primary department.
 This report was approved -
 It was decided that the members of the
 committee should solicit the usual subscription
 from our members -

The question of Corinth school was then discussed.
 The committee to take charge of the school
 had not been appointed in lower monthly
 meeting. as was suggested by the Yearly Meeting's
 Committee and the public school has been
 started which 21 friends children attend. They
 request that the \$250 appropriated to Corinth
 be divided between the two schools -

 with friends at Corinth to find out the

situation so as to see what disposition
 of the funds appropriated for that
 neighborhood should be made -
