It appears to this Meeting that there is no persons appointed in Herring
Creek & Elks weekly Meeting to attend the Service off yearly Meet-
ing therefore appoints Joseph Galloway Joseph Richardson Dan^l
Richardson and John Wilkinson to Read to friend of the said
weekly Meeting a Minute made in our last yearly Meeting Relating
to that Business and treat with friend of each Meeting aforesaid to
obtain a Compliance there with

This Meeting being informed by a member there of who had
lately visited Elkridge Meeting that he was apprehensive that
seventeen Persons there to belonging or attending contrary to
Christian order had at Evening the 21st Day of 4th mo last fell
into a strange Supposition of Minds all praying or preach-
ing at once or so many of them that it could not be distinguished
what was said by any one of them and continued all night and
several Days continued pray & Preaching in their Meeting House
Several Persons at one time where in several unbound & improper
Speeches has been delivered and the friendly and neighborly advices al-
ready given by several friends not accepted where upon this Meeting

has taken under Consideration that the Good advice of the apostle
to the Church or Churches in his time was that they should watch one
another in Love one of an for the good one of another and ad-
vise that all things should be done Decently & in order and that the
Prophets might speak two or three one by one and if any thing be
Revealed to another that sitteth by let the first hold his peace
therefore these People having appeared thus wide of good Christian
order are desired to repent of their Errors and keep out there off for
the time to come and make such necessary acknowledgment thereof
in our Quarterly Meeting as friend in the wisdom and ability it may
please God to give shall deem necessary and it is also desired that
they keep their Meetings in Silence waiting upon God for the Re-
newing of his mercy unto them that there by may be delivered
from all the ^{deceiving} ~~deceiving~~ powers of Darkness and self conceits and so
first come to know the saving truth of God for them selves before
presume to put them to sleep up for teachers of others and in order
that these our advices be not neglected this meeting appoints our
