This Meeting Appoints Mordecai Price: Rees Howan: Joseph Taylor: Samuel Hopkins: Gerrard Hopkins: Phillip Hopkins: Gerrard Ball: Samuel Robertson: James Brooke & Joseph Richardson to attend the Service of the ensuing Yearly Meeting with an acc't of the State of the Meetings within the Jurisdiction of this Quarterly Meeting.

At our Quarterly Meeting held at Westriver the 8th Day of the 8th mo 1753- the proceedings thereof being as followeth. The account brought into this Meeting from the Monthly Meetings of friends in Baltimore County and Herring Creek it appears that the said Monthly Meetings are constantly kept according to appointment, and the business thereof Transacted in Love: and that most of the several weekly Meetings thereto belonging are for the most part constantly kept and a good Degree of Love and Unity abounding amongst friends.
